

## Now Enrolling Typically Hearing Peers for the 2025-2026 School Year!











Listen and Talk's Blended Classroom Program is an inclusive early childhood program where children who are deaf or hard-of-hearing learn and play side-byside with children who have typical hearing. We offer small, age-mixed classes up to eight children. Our teachers create language-rich environments and engage children in active learning which promotes the development of critical thinking, social and pre-academic skills.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT BLENDED CLASSROOM PROGRAM

How many spots are available next year?

To maintain small class sizes, we hold up to two spots in each class for children with typical hearing. For 2024-2025, we have four spots available.

Is enrollment limited to the fall?

We enroll students throughout the school year!

What does the daily schedule look like?

## Four - day program:

- 8:30am 2:30pm (Mon/Tues/Weds/Th)
- No school on Fridays
- For children 3 4 years old by August

## Five - day program

- 8:30am 2:30pm (Mon/Tues/Weds/Th)
- 8:30am 12:00pm Friday
- For children 4½ to 5 years old entering Kindergarten next school year.

We provide a short, quiet break around midday with no nap time. Does this program operate year-round?

We follow Seattle Public Schools calendar with some additional nonstudent days. In July, we host a short summer program at our Kirkland, Washington campus.

Do we offer before and after-school care?

No, we do not offer any before or after school-care.

Do students need to know ASL?

No, we communicate using listening and spoken language.

What are the enrollment criteria?

Students must be potty trained and be typically developing.
